- Visit Rosenstrasse, where German women courageously protested against the Nazi arrest of their Jewish husbands, creating one of the most remarkable public acts of resistance within Nazi Germany.
- Discover the influence of the renowned Jewish architect Erich Mendelsohn, whose groundbreaking modernist designs helped shape Berlin’s architectural identity.
- Pause at the moving Memorial to the Murdered Jews of Europe before enjoying free time in Berlin’s fashionable Mitte district.

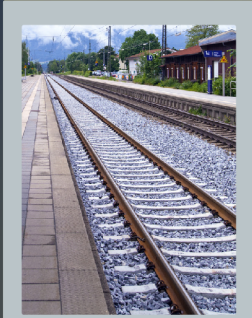

Day 4, Memory Along the Lakes: Wannsee, Gleis 17, and Refined Berlin

- Upon returning to central Berlin, enjoy lunch on own at Kaufhaus des Westens (KaDeWe), Berlin's legendary luxury department store known for its gourmet food halls, designer shopping, and elegant culinary experiences.
- Drive through the leafy boulevards and upscale residential neighborhoods of western Berlin, discovering a more refined and relaxed side of the city.
- Enjoy free time for spa treatments, boutique shopping, museums, or café culture.
- Optional classical music or concert experience in the evening.

- Attend Friday night services at a local synagogue before enjoying an elegant Shabbat dinner with warm hospitality and contemporary Jewish Berlin ambiance.

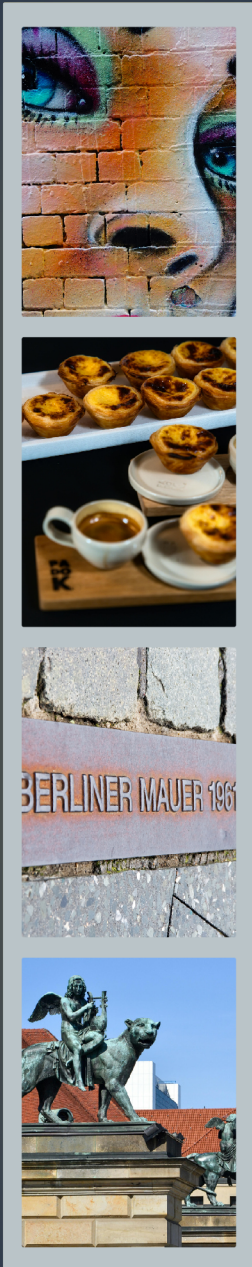
